ETIBAR PANAHOV- 70



1 January 1955 is the 70th birthday anniversary of Doctor of Mathematical Sciences, Professor of the Institute of Applied Mathematics of Baku State University Etibar Panahov.

He was born 1 January 1955 in Kalinino region of Armenia.

Etibar Panahov graduated from Faculty of Mechanics and Mathematics of Azerbaijan State University in 1976. He got his Doctor of Sciences degree in 2017. He was a postgraduate student of the Mathematics Department of the Faculty of Mechanics and Mathematics of Moscow State University in 1976-1979, and in 1981, under the guidance Professor B.M. Levitan, he defended his candidate's thesis.

Etibar Panahov is a world-renowned specialist and expert in the field of direct and inverse problems of the spectral theory of differential operators. His scientific research is mainly in two directions: Spectral analysis of regular and singular Sturm-Liouville, Dirac, Diffusion, Integro-differential, etc. operators and inverse problems of potential theory.

He is an author of more than 180 scientific works. Under his scientific leadership 15 people were awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy.

Etibar Panahov worked as a Professor Dr. in the Mathematics Department of the Faculty of Science of Firat University in Elazig, Turkey, from 1996 to 2015. Here, he was the head of the Mathematics Department, a member of the Senate, and the rector's advisor for relations with Turkic-speaking countries.

Etibar Panahov is one of the main organizers of the Turkic World Mathematicians Society (TWMS-1999) and has been the vice president of this organization, representing Turkey and Azerbaijan for 25 years. He has been one of the main organizers of seven TWMS congresses held so far. He has worked as a visiting professor in 1989 at the Madras Mathematical Institute and the Bangalore Institute of Applied Mathematics (India); in 1990 at the Montpellier Institute of Physics Research (France); in 1995 at the Zanzan Institute of Physics Research and Tehran Sharif University (Iran); in 2011 at the City University (Hong-Gong), in 2016 at the Gumilyov Astana University (Kazakhstan), in 2019 at the University of La Roche (France) and etc. Professor Etibar Panahov is a co-editor-in-chief of the "TWMS Journal of Pure and Applied Mathematics" and is doing all his best for development of this journal.
